

Explore Oregon

Explore Oregon gives pilots the opportunity explore our beautiful state by air. With Explore Oregon you have the opportunity to visit new places; **and** a chance to win a gift certificate from Spruce Aircraft.

This year, Explore Oregon is open to **all** of Oregon's Public Use Airport. There is a link to the Public Use Airports on the OPA & ODA website. With all flights, it is the **pilot's responsibility** to research the airport, personal pilot skill level and the aircraft capability to ensure that the selected airport is within your personal safety standard. Some of the airports listed require a high skill level. Pilots may fly to any Public Use Airport in any order, within the 6 months between April 6 & October 6, 2018.

Explore Oregon starts on 6 April 2018. Explore Oregon ends on Saturday 6 October 2018 at the Albany Airport. The Albany EAA Chapter will host a Bar-B-Q for a \$5 donation. The donations are used to advance aviation for young people.

To get a raffle ticket, simply print a picture of your airplane at each airport visited. To get a **second** raffle ticket (from that **same** airport) simply, attach a receipt from a restaurant or an attraction in the area, to the airport picture. Ask a restaurant or attraction employee to write: "thanks for flying in" on the receipt. Your home airport cannot be used for the raffle. There is **NO** "Passport Book" this year. Just bring your pictures to Albany on 6 October.

There are **4** - \$200 gift certificates selected by raffle.

There is one - \$200 gift certificate for the participant who flies to the most airports (cutting a deck of cards will determine the winner if there is a tie).

One winning ticket per person.

Bring your pictures, with receipts attached to the picture (if applicable) to the Albany Airport on 6 October 2018 no later than 1:00 PM. It will cost \$25 for OPA members when you turn in your pictures/receipts in exchange for raffle tickets. It will cost non-OPA members \$35 which **includes** membership to the Oregon Pilots Association. 6 October is also the date for OPA's Poker Run.

"At Large" OPA members can also "Fly-in" to the Oregon International Air Show.
